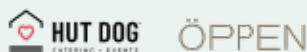

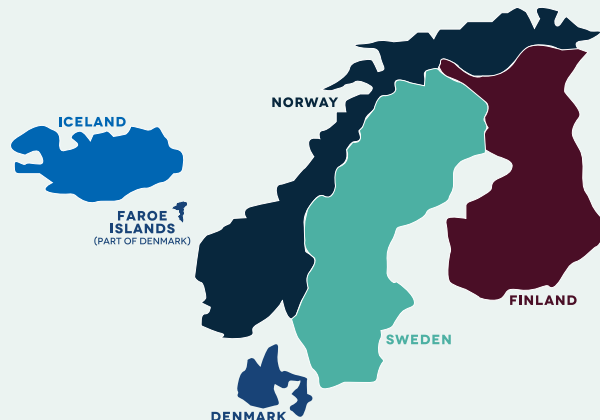

MARGRETE – QUEEN OF THE NORTH

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

From acclaimed director Charlotte Sieling (*Borgen*, *The Killing*, *The Bridge*), *Margrete - Queen of the North* brings the story of one of the most powerful women in Nordic history to the big screen. In the year 1402, Denmark's Queen Margrete (Trine Dyrholm) has achieved what no man has managed before. She has gathered Denmark, Norway and Sweden into a peace-oriented union, which she single-handedly rules through her young, adopted son, Erik (Morten Hee Andersen). However, the union is beset by enemies and therefore Margrete is planning a marriage between Erik and an English princess. An alliance with England should secure the union's status as an emerging European power, but a breathtaking conspiracy is under way that could tear Margrete and all that she believes in apart. Directed and co-written by Sieling and inspired by actual events surrounding the reign of Queen Margrete I, *Margrete - Queen of the North* is a lavish historical drama that blends grand visuals with the psychological unease of a chamber piece, exploring the legacy of a visionary ruler who brokered the historic Kalmar Union.

An idiosyncratic dark comedy direct from the 2022 Cannes Film Festival Critics' Week, *The Woodcutter Story* is a surreal exploration of the meaning of life. Pepe (the commanding Jarkko Lahti, *Helene*, *ScandiFF2021*, *The Happiest Day of Olli Mäki*) is a sweet-natured woodcutter in an idyllic small town in northern Finland. Surrounded by friends and family who gather in the evenings around dinner and card games, Pepe is content with his simple existence. Over the span of a couple of days, a series of events gradually destroys the quiet and happy life he once had, yet Pepe remains unfazed. As the ensuing days throw all sorts of chaos, strife and surreal adventure at him, Pepe remains determined to look on the bright side. Always smiling, always optimistic, as if he knows a secret to existence that no one else does. Shot on 35mm film and featuring deadpan humour, the snow-covered haunting and absurd fairy tale *The Woodcutter Story* is the feature film directorial debut from Mikko Myllylahti, writer of Cannes Un Certain Regard winner *The Happiest Day of Olli Mäki*.

Starring Lisa Carlehed (*The Tunnel*) and Gustav Skarsgård (*Vikings*), this stylish new adaptation of *The Emigrants* from internationally acclaimed Norwegian director Erik Poppe (*The King's Choice*, *ScandiFF2017*) is an epic period drama. During the mid-19th century, millions of Scandinavians left hunger and distress in the hope of a better life in America. In this monumental tale, we follow Kristina (Lisa Carlehed), Karl Oskar (Gustav Skarsgård) and their young children who leave a poverty-stricken Sweden in the 1850s and set out on a long, dangerous journey across the Atlantic and into wild North America. Based on Vilhelm Moberg's much loved best-selling series of novels which were adapted in 1971 by Jan Troell into an award-winning and Oscar nominated film, the story is now being told on film for the first time from Kristina's perspective. With an ensemble cast featuring Swedish pop sensation Tove Lo, Sofia Helin and Lena Strömdahl, *The Emigrants* (2021) stands out as a poignant yet timeless story about who we are, where we belong, and how far we are willing to go to save our children and achieve our dreams.

Celebrating its 50th anniversary, Jan Troell's monumental mid-nineteenth century epic *The New Land*, the sequel to last year's Closing Night film, *The Emigrants*, follows a Swedish farming family's effort to put down roots in the United States, a beautiful but forbidding new world. Cinema legends Max von Sydow and Liv Ullmann deliver remarkably authentic performances as Karl Oskar and Kristina, a couple who meet with one physical and emotional trial after another, having experienced an arduous journey to America from Sweden, and now living in the wilderness of Minnesota. While clearing and farming their land, they must deal with the brutal realities of American frontier life, including a fierce Sioux uprising and the bloody Civil War, along with family squabbles and the lure of the gold fields of California. Based on Swedish author Vilhelm Moberg's four-part series of novels about the mid-nineteenth-century wave of emigration from Sweden to the United States, Troell's engrossing drama depicts with precise detail their story, a story which is also that of countless other people who sought better lives across the Atlantic.

A husband, a doctor, a wife, a student and a young daughter are unsuspectingly put on a collision course with each of their fateful crossroads. In the search for love, identity and moral gauge, they all risk the most precious aspect of life – trust. But trust is vulnerable and the consequences will be irreversible, forbidden and embarrassingly amusing.

Here, the power couple Maggie (Katrine Greis-Rosenthal, *A Fortunate Man*) and Carsten (Nikolaj Coster-Waldau, *Game of Thrones*) rule on the Danish gourmet scene. Maggie is an anthropologist who has created the extraordinary setting of the restaurant, and Carsten is a renowned chef who works his magic in the kitchen. They love each other, have two wonderful children, and own one of the most hyped restaurants in Copenhagen. They want it all and they have it all, except for the prestigious Michelin star they so desperately covet. In the relentless pursuit for perfection, the couple is willing to sacrifice everything to achieve their dream. From their sweet first meeting they are eventually confronted by a sour betrayal resulting in a heated climax when all of the elements combine. This fascinating culinary documentary follows the endearing yet brutal everyday life of the Faroe Islands and its culinary pearl, two-star Michelin restaurant KOKS. The Faroe Islands are an ancient microcosmos of exciting products, Nordic history, a thriving seafood industry, stunning landscapes and eccentric personalities. Prior to COVID-19, people took immense detours to dine at KOKS, an eatery serving food sourced from just 500 square miles of produce, in a rugged terrain and subpolar climate, with average temperatures close to freezing throughout the year, everlasting light in summer and scorching darkness through winter. Filmed over an 18-month period, *Nordic by Nature* dives into the poetic mind of young Faroese chef Poul Andrias Ziska, exploring the traditions, history and distinctive ancient practices that lie beneath the world's most remote fine dining experience. Five years after his successful *Michelin Stars: Tales from the Kitchen*, director Rasmus Dinesen returns with the story of young, down-to-earth chef Ziska and his team, attempting to combine local cooking traditions with modern cuisine amid the beauty and wilderness of the Faroe Islands.

Boasting a stellar ensemble cast with some of Denmark's most promising young talent, including Andrea Heick Gadeberg (*Riders of Justice*), Sylvester Byder (*Deliver Us*), Albert Rudbeck Lindhardt (*Another Round*) and Karoline Hamm (*Equinox*), coming-of-age drama *Pretty Young Thing* follows six teenage boys and girls whose personal boundaries are challenged at their new school. It's a new school year and at Rosenholm High School there are many initiation rituals that the new first-year students must go through, which are of great importance for their future life in high school, not least for their personal life.

Best friends and freshmen Frida and Selma quickly become friends with another first-year student Nadja. When Frida catches feelings for Nadja's older boyfriend Emil and is invited to the ritual party for first-year students but Selma is not, their friendship starts to fall apart. Written by award-winning scriptwriter Line Mørkeby (*When the Dust Settles*) and directed by Tilde Harkamp (*Hunting Season*), *Pretty Young Thing* delves into the Danish high school tradition of freshman dinners, where third-year boys ask first-year girls to boozy dinner parties, and explores party culture, sexualisation and youth's search for identity.

It is 1948 and 63-year-old Danish author Karen Blixen (Birthe Neumann, *Happy Ending ScandiFF2019*) is at the pinnacle of her fame and next in line to win the Nobel Prize for literature. It has been 17 years since she gave up her famous farm in Africa only to return to Denmark with her life in ruins. Devastated by syphilis and having lost the love of her life she has reinvented herself as a literary sensation. Karen is an isolated genius, until the day she meets the talented 30-year-old poet Thorkild Bjørnvig (Simon Bennebjerg), promising him literary stardom if he will obey her unconditionally in return, even at the cost of him losing everything else in his life. Based on the true story of *Out of Africa* author Karen Blixen, compelling slow burn drama *The Pact* recounts Blixen's later life and explores the literary titan's toxic mentorship of young poet Bjørnvig. Directed by the award-winning Bille August (*Pelle the Conqueror*, *House of Spirits*), this sterling adaptation of Bjørnvig's bestselling memoir delivers a well-crafted character study of an icon and her influence.

In this warm-hearted romantic comedy, superstar singer Seija Kuula (Hannele Lauri) soon-to-be 70, is trying to cope with her career, age and love. On stage, Seija sparkles in the light of the audience's loving gaze, but at home she finds it difficult to get close to anyone. When Seija falls in love with a younger man, 40-something Lauri (Mikko Nousiainen), the relationship gets complicated when Lauri introduces her to his mother. Lauri wants children and Mirre wants to be a granny. When Seija's stylist and closest friend Shanella suffers from a bad case of baby fever, Seija creates a masterplan to make everybody happy, only to realise that love is a dangerous game.

A tribute to Finnish female artists, the film features several hits loved by the nation. Combining friendships, dreams of starting a family, a parent-child relationship and an atypical intimate relationship, this film explores the many dimensions of love and tells the story of relationships, regardless of age. Directed and written by Finnish comedy queen Johanna Vuoksenmaa, *70 is Just a Number* is a touching and humorous coming-of-age-story – at 70.

Starring Anita Briem (*The Tudors, The Minister*) and Edda Björgvinsdóttir (*Under the Tree, The Valhalla Murders*), *Quake* is an absorbing psychological-mystery drama. It is winter in Reykjavik and Saga (Briem), a single mother in her late thirties, is hit by a fierce epileptic attack while walking in a park with her six-year-old son, resulting in total memory loss.
